

## Documentation Examples

You will need to bring several documents to your WIC appointment. Please ask your WIC local agency which documents are required. The types of documents that you may need, and examples of each, are listed below.

### Proof of Identity

#### Woman

##### (Bring in one)

- Photo Identification (Driver's License or Passport)
- Work/School ID Card
- Social Security Card
- Voter Registration
- Woman's Birth Certificate
- Tribal ID Card
- Military ID
- Hospital ID Bracelet
- Medical Records

#### Child/Infant

##### (Bring in one)

- Child's Birth Certificate
- Immunization Records
- Hospital ID Bracelet
- Medical Records
- Adoption Papers

### Proof of Income Eligibility

##### (Bring in all that apply)

- Recent paycheck stubs or copies of paychecks
- Recent Income Tax Return
- Social Security or SSI
- Unemployment benefit checks
- Proof of Child Support or Alimony
- Signed statement by employer or signed statement of no income (with explanation)
- Business Account Statements (if you are self-employed)

### Proof of Residential Eligibility

##### (Bring in one)

- Current Utility Bill (phone, gas, water, etc.)
- Rent or mortgage receipt/lease agreement
- Voter Registration with current address
- Written statement from reliable third party

### Proof of Pregnancy Examples

##### (Bring in one)

- Estimated Date of Conception (EDC) statement
- Expected Date of Delivery (EDD) statement
- Positive pregnancy test statement from health care facility
- Sonogram

**Note:** Proof of pregnancy may or may not be required in your State, please check with your WIC local agency for confirmation.
